ZOOM SOFTWARE UPDATE

About the Update: Zoom has released its software update to enhance privacy and security. This update introduces the following new features:

- a) Security toolbar icon for hosts which exposes all of Zoom's existing in-meeting security controls in one place
- b) The button to invite others to join your Zoom meeting is now available at the bottom of the participants' panel
- c) The meeting ID will no longer be displayed in the title bar of the Zoom meeting window
- d) The attendee attention tracking feature has been removed

Action Required: **Immediately update your Zoom application** (both on phone, desktop and laptop) to this latest software release in order to take advantage of these new features.
